What is Stewardship Formation


Webster says: formation is the act of forming or creating something


Once one professes to be a disciple of Jesus Christ, stewardship is not an option.

- Return them with increase to the Lord









Hospitality

Learning to see others through the lenses of Christ opens our hearts and changes everything.


- Understanding that the people in your parish and local communities are not labels but are people of story and experience
- When we are together at Mass, we belong to each other and need to be present to each other
















HIGHLIGHTING CREATION


