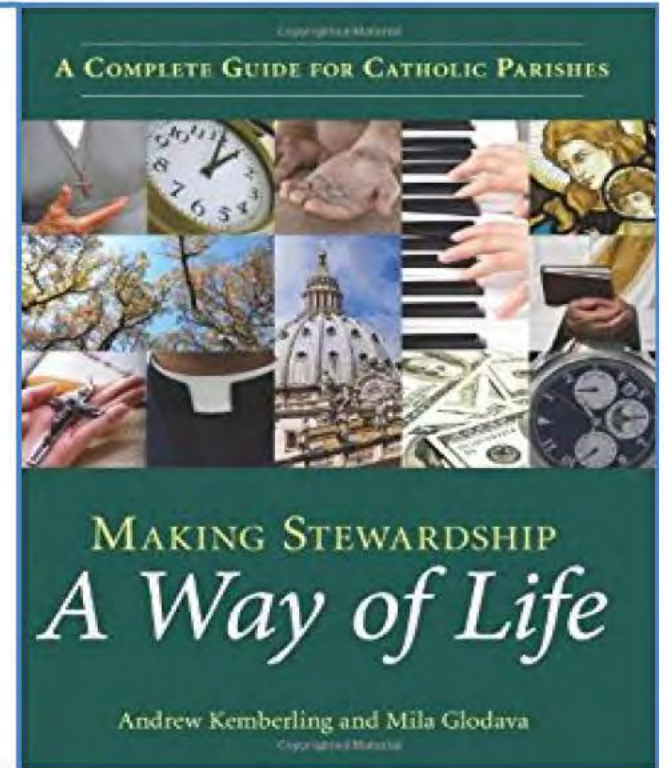
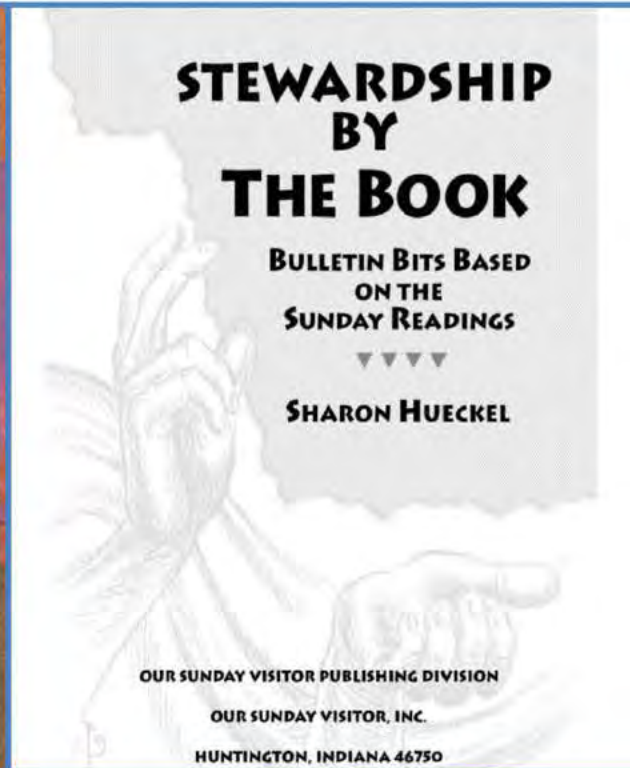
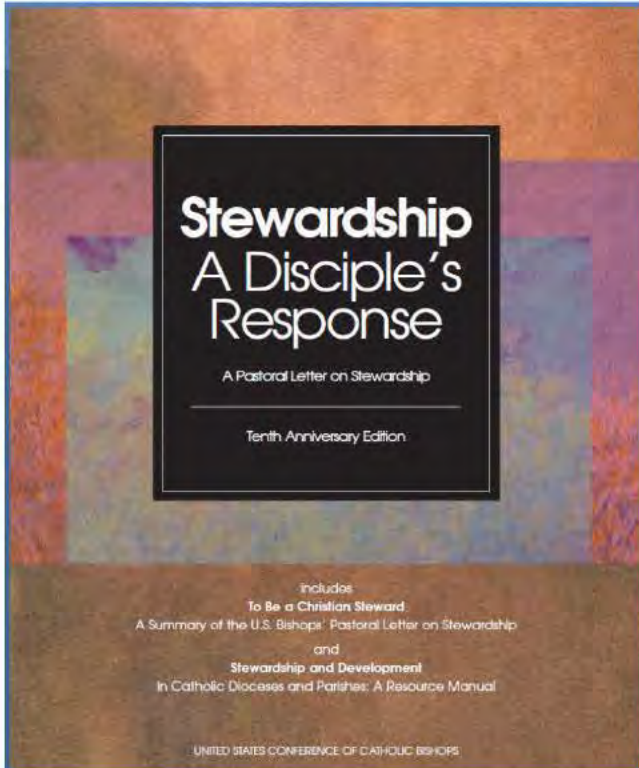

Best Practices for Commitment weekend

- Be prepared! Plan and walk through this process with the facilitators, the Pastor, the Lay Witness speakers, and organist in advance
- Place the Commitment Cards in the back of church for all 6 weeks of the program
- Have new parishioner registration forms visible in the back of church at all Masses
- Thank the parishioners before and after the process

Lay Speakers and Ushers

Try to keep the talk to 5-7 minutes and outline:

- Who you are in general
- Why you go to your parish
- How you are involved
- What motivates you to give of your time/talent/treasure
- How your life has been impacted or how you have been able to impact others through the church
- Wrap up with something inviting everyone to make a commitment together

Basically for the ushers:

1. Read the brochure ahead of time in case anyone has any questions.
2. Have the cards ready for after mass in case anyone has questions.
3. Smile 😊.
4. The cards will be collected with the offertory or can be turned in following mass.
5. They should be compiled and banded for the office.
6. Mass will move on without further changes.

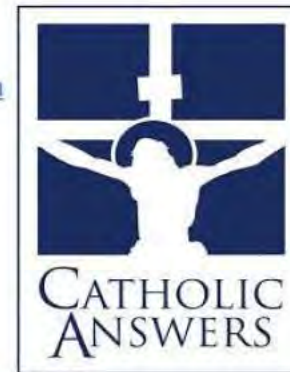

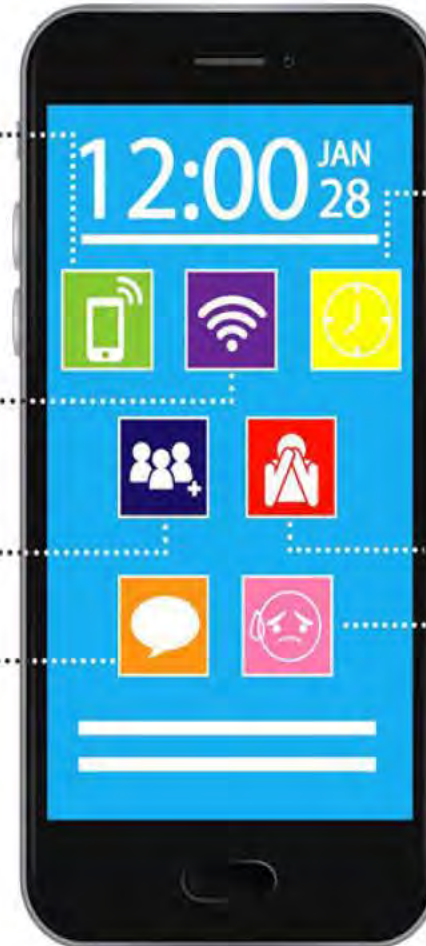

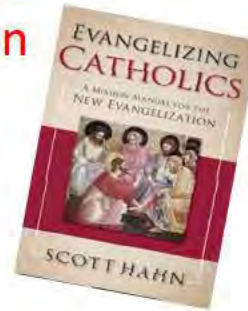

Most significant was the hiring of additional pastoral staff to provide needed services for our community. The Pastoral Council is on the process of evaluating the current pastoral plan and aligning it with the new Diocesan Pastoral plan, **Stewards of the Gospel**. New goals and ministries will be added (especially in the area of social ministry) and will need your continued stewardship of time, talent and treasure to keep these initiatives going.

For the past years, the parish conducted series of renovations and updated our place of worship. Much has been completed and we have all enjoyed our renovated church, complete with air-conditioning, improved lighting and sound system, installation of solar system for both the parish and school, exterior painting of the church and much more. Before the end of this year, we hope to finish the bell restoration project. Needed maintenance is also on-going in the pastoral center and rectory.

As a result of these significant changes, the Co-Cathedral of St. Theresa of the Child Jesus is now faced with a financial challenge we must address with urgency. Aside from the required maintenance of our facilities, the parish is still paying the loan borrowed for the interior renovations of the church. Also, we are still short of funds needed for the exterior painting of the rectory and the pastoral center.

One way of addressing the financial support for these priorities is by moving forward with concerted effort to increase our Sunday Offertory Collection. **Increasing our offertory will help the parish immensely.** I am aware that much has already been asked of you. Some families and individuals are already experiencing difficult financial times. I'm sure the cost of running your household continues to increase every year, so also is the cost of running our parish. I am counting on the many, who are able, to make additional sacrifices to increase their weekly offering.

Please review the contents of this special brochure and **consider how you can help our parish.** Our goal through this program is to substantially increase our regular offertory contributions. Please review the suggested guidelines for giving on the enclosed Commitment Card. A special Commitment Sunday will be held at Mass the weekend of **October 29th and 30th.** Please bring the enclosed Commitment Card to Mass next weekend prepared to renew your weekly offertory gift **to support the works of the Co-Cathedral of St. Theresa of the Child Jesus.**

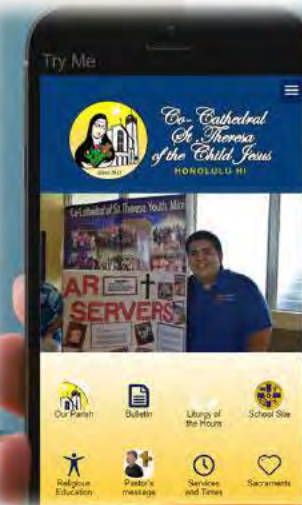

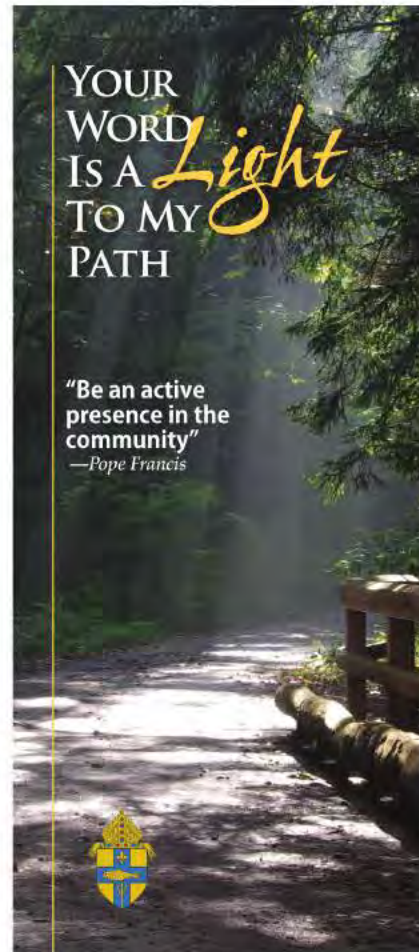
