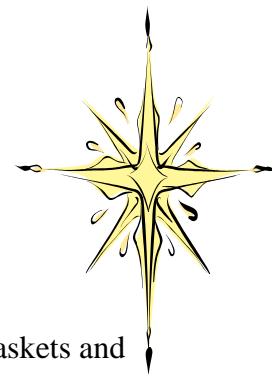

**Ideas for Care Basket Items**

It is best to use a plastic laundry basket or brightly decorated, sturdy box for the care baskets and fill them with such items as:

**Non-perishables**

- Canned Tuna
- Canned meat, such as Corned Beef, Vienna Sausage
- Canned Chicken or Turkey
- Cereal
- Powdered Milk
- Macaroni and Cheese/other boxed meals
- Jello, Pudding (ready serve or boxes)
- Canned juices, fruits, vegetables, sauces, soups
- Pasta and other dry noodle products

**Basic necessities**

- Bath soap
- Toothpaste
- Toothbrushes
- Dental Floss
- Shampoo
- Conditioner
- Deodorant
- Dish Liquid
- Detergent/Fabric Softener
- Toilet Paper
- Paper Towels

**Other items**

- Crackers (especially animal crackers)
- Microwaveable Popcorn
- Packaged Cookies or other packaged treats for kids
- Gift certificates for food at various supermarkets
