



**APP CHALLENGE 2016**

**GUIDELINES**

**Who can participate?**

- Any 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade Homeroom or Religion class can be part of the 2016 APP Challenge. Points for the class are acquired by student participants throughout the Lenten Season.

**How do you score points?**

- Students receive one point for each of the following:  
(3 points maximum for each week)
  1. Email a letter to the person featured in the Story of Hope (SOH).
  2. Email a reflection on the theme of Catholic Social Teaching for the week.
  3. Email a prayer for the country/family/person in the SOH.
- The minimum word count for each email is 100 and the maximum is 150

**STEP ONE:** Teachers are asked to shoot a quick email to [psmvol@rcchawaii.org](mailto:psmvol@rcchawaii.org) letting our office know that your class will be participating.

We plan to post pictures of participating classes onto our diocesan website. The Office for Social Ministry will forward a diocesan release form for your parents to sign. Photos of every class will be posted and in some instances prayers, letters or reflections. Once you receive everyone's form, scan and email (your class) forms as a single pdf file to OSM along with a group picture of your students. The weekly point tally will be posted on our website next to your class picture.

**STEP TWO:** Each participating class will be assigned to a member of our reviewing team. You will be given an email address where your students are to send their letters, reflections and prayers.

We will track emails by grade homeroom (HR) or religion class (R). Students are to type the subject line for every email as follows:

[1] school code [2] grade level [3] religion or homeroom class, [4] student's last name

Here is an example:

**Subject: SF, 7, R, Fautanu** = St Francis School / 7<sup>th</sup> Grade / Religion Class / Miss Fautanu

**STEP THREE:** The last day for the challenge is March 24, 2016 – Holy Thursday. An announcement of APP CHALLENGE WINNERS will be released soon after Easter.
