

Description

Goal:

To provide to the Church and families a beautiful and positive Catholic-centered approach to human sexuality education within the context of the meaning of family love, friendship love, and married love. Each program is ageappropriate, gender specific, and family based.

The LoveEd Program is a response to the US Bishop's Document *Catechetical Guidelines in Chaste Living* and the Vatican Pontifical Council for the Family's *The Truth and Meaning of Human Sexuality*. Methodology of Program:
