 - A method of selecting new council members that includes parishioner education and nomination, two sessions to allow nominees to discern their call to pastoral council ministry, and suggestions for final selection of council members.
- 3. Orientation sessions for new council members
 - An overview of the work of the pastoral council including a review of recent issues and recommendation, current concerns and initiatives under discussion, a review of the Diocesan Guidelines for Pastoral Councils and the parish guidelines for operations.

 - Questions to help parishes develop their own council operations, including number of members, member criteria, terms of office, meeting dates, selecting new members, etc.

 - Sample questions for council members to assess their effectiveness using criteria from the Guidelines.

 - Behaviors that can enhance the effectiveness of any parish meeting including setting an agenda and making it available to members prior to a meeting, the role of the chair and secretary, importance of prayer, dealing with conflict, etc.

 - Provides an outline for writing goals, objectives and actions needed to achieve the goals.

 - A sample agenda for an annual meeting of Pastoral and Finance Councils and heads of core parish ministries.

 - Sample questions using the Young and Young Adult priority.
 Substitute other questions and other priorities as needed.

 - Sample survey that asks questions about all parish ministries and concerns.
- 17. Tools to develop and use a parish mission statement
 - Sample questions to help guide the development or revision of a parish mission statement. A parish mission statement can make Jesus' mission concrete in the particular locale and time in which the parish operates.
