## **Living Catholic in the 808: 1<sup>st</sup> Joyful Mystery: The Annunciation**

Luke 1:35 (NAB): “The Holy Spirit will come upon you and the power of the Most High will overshadow you”

How do we evangelize? First and foremost, “BE A PERSON OF PRAYER”.

Perhaps, some are afraid to share the Good News because we do not know what to say or we feel unworthy. Or the opposite can happen – we are so fired up to share the Good News because of our own eloquence or competence.

The 1<sup>st</sup> joyful mystery teaches us that we evangelize only by cooperating with God. Mary was with the Holy Spirit from the Incarnation of Jesus up to Pentecost with the Apostles. We are able to evangelize with the power of the Holy Spirit, not with our own power. Immersed in God through prayer and the Eucharist, we are overshadowed by the Holy Spirit. Thus, we can evangelize.

*“Do not worry about how you are to speak. You will be given at that moment what you are to say. For it will not be you who speak but the Holy Spirit of your Father speaking through you.” (Mt 10:19-20)*

**Let us be open to be used by God. Pray daily and reverently.**
