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Living Catholic in the 808 The Trinity and Evangelization

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The Trinity is not some "yawn worthy" doctrine that we recite belief in at every Sunday Mass. The Trinity is actually the core of what we evangelize, what we can and should evangelize, when we evangelize with words. Namely:

- God (the Father, creator) loves us into being, and into the very likeness and image of God's very self.
- We forget this fact, the core of who we are, and we sin. We hurt one another, our planet, ourselves.
- God STILL loves us so much that God literally becomes a human being (Jesus Christ, his only Son). And God does this while still staying fully, totally, 100% still divine, still God!
- better, God (the Holy Spirit) lives and moves in each and every of us Christians, moving us ever closer in communion with one another, in life and in life after death, moving ALL imperceptibly into fulfillment of God's kingdom.

These bullet points are what we call the kerygma, meaning the very core, the essence of our faith. Easier to remember, it is our creed. Even easier to remember, it is the Trinity.
