As of March 31, 2011, the generous and faithful donors of the With Grateful Hearts Capital Campaign have contributed a total of \$16,016,714.


Currently all parishes throughout the Diocese of Honolulu are receiving quarterly disbursements based on their actual cash collected. To date our 66 parishes and two communities have received over \$5.8 Million. In addition, all campaign intentions are eligible to a receive a percentage of their total projected allocations.

The Hawaii Catholic Community Foundation continues to accept Request for Funding Applications thru coordinating Diocesan Department Heads to enhance programming throughout the diocese. Proposals must meet certain campaign intention criteria to be considered. To date over \$10 Million has been allocated for intentions.

God has truly blessed our island 'ohana. What an exciting time to be a part of the Diocese of Honolulu!
