Keynote Speakers



Jim Beckman serves as the Executive Director of Evangelization and Catechesis for the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City. He has been

involved with Diocesan and parish ministry, evangelization, and leadership development for more than 30 years. Jim is the Executive Director of Impact Center, a non-profit dedicated to leadership development in the Catholic Church and an adjunct professor for the Augustine Institute, teaching on topics of leadership, evangelization and discipleship. He was first elected to the National Service Committee in 2015, and again in 2018.



Father Joseph Freedy grew up in Bethel Park, Pennsylvania where he attended St. Thomas More grade school followed by Bethel Park High School. He earned a scholarship to the

University at Buffalo to play football. After college, he entered St. Paul Seminary in Pittsburgh and then was assigned to the North American College in Rome where he studied at the Gregorian University followed by the John Paul Institute. He was ordained a priest in 2008. In 2017, he became the parochial vicar at Holy Child and St. Barbara Parishes in Bridgeville, Pennsylvania.

Catholic Charities Hawaii is located on the Clarence T. C. Ching Campus at 1822 Ke'eaumoku Street in Honolulu. The Community Hall is handicapped accessible. There are parking stalls under the hall and are arranged for double parking. Off-street parking is also available. The Community Hall can get cold so please bring a light sweater or jacket for your comfort.

City Bus Service

City bus service is available daily, every 35 minutes until 9:20 p.m. by Route 17 along Ke'eaumoku Street from Ala Moana Shopping Center with a stop directly across Catholic Charities. Frequent service is available from Routes 1 and 2 along Beretania and King Streets, 2/3 mile south

and Routes 4 and 18 along Wilder Street, three blocks south.

Meals

A meal plan for lunch and dinner on Saturday is available at a cost of \$10 for those who register by December 31, 2018. Meals will not be sold on-site. Many restaurants and cafes are located just 7-8 blocks south of Catholic Charities Hawaii. Many also participate in a potluck fellowship in the plaza area, between the Community Hall and the administration building.

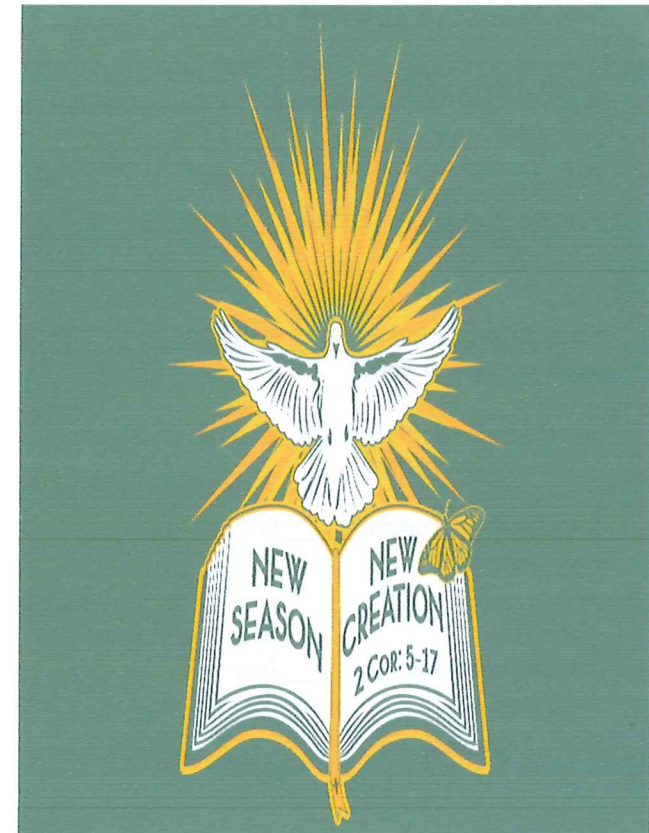
